Inaugurates Visiting Fellow Program

Jonathan Kirshner, a professor of government and director of the Reppy Institute for Peace and Conflict Studies at Cornell University, has been named the first annual *World Politics* visiting fellow for the academic year 2012–13. His position is effective September 1.

While at Princeton, Kirshner, whose career has focused on exploring the essential relationship between economics and international politics, will work on a research project that considers American power and world politics after the financial crisis.
