Handicapped' throughout; and, for example, the number of hospital beds for a population of 200,000 in Scotland would be 240 ('Services for the Mentally Handicapped', Scottish Home and Health and Education Departments, 1972), not 136. The Memorandum on Child Psychiatry Services in the same

issue recognizes the Scottish differences, which are more significant in the field of mental handicap.

Library Lending Department Regulations

- 1. Books shall be lent to members within the United Kingdom and Eire who are not in arrears with their subscriptions.
- 2. No member may borrow from the Library more than three volumes at one time.
- 3. Books and journals are sent carriage paid from the Library, but members are responsible for the books from the time they leave the Library until they are received back, and for the return postage.
- 4. Books damaged or lost while in possession of a member will be repaired at his expense or must be replaced by him.
- 5. A member shall be entitled to retain a book or periodical borrowed from the Library for a period of twenty-eight days (or longer by special arrangement), unless the book is required by another member, in which case it can be recalled by the Librarian at the expiration of fourteen days.
- 6. In the event of a member failing to return any book or periodical within seven days after receiving notice from the Librarian (on the expiration of the period referred to in Rule 5), the Library Committee shall be at liberty to purchase another copy, the cost to be charged to such member, who shall not be allowed to borrow another book until the sum thus expended shall have been paid.

Gaskell Gold Medal and Prize

The examination for this prize is held in May of each year. In addition to a Gold Medal the award attached to the prize is £75. The prize has always been considered one of the foremost academic distinctions obtainable in clinical psychiatry, and Members of the College are asked to bring it to the notice of suitable candidates who may be eligible to compete.

An entrance fee of £3.15 is charged, returnable to

bona-fide candidates. Entries must reach the Dean not later than 31 March in each year.

Bronze Medal and Prize

This prize is awarded annually for the best Dissertation submitted under conditions printed in the Year-book. Candidates are reminded that Dissertations must reach the Dean before 30 April in each year, and must not exceed 10,000 words in length.

Divisional Prizes

Papers certified as eligible for this competition must be forwarded to reach the Dean not later than 30 April in each year.
