

GENERAL NOTES

THE INSTITUTE OF LARYNGOLOGY AND OTOTOLOGY

THE Senate of the University of London has approved the establishment of a Professorial Unit at the Institute and the institution of a Chair in Laryngology and Otology. It has appointed Mr. Frank Cunliffe Ormerod to this Chair as from October 1st, 1949. Mr. Ormerod has been a member of the Staff of the Royal National Throat, Nose and Ear Hospital (to which the Institute is attached) for twenty-eight years. He took a prominent part in the arrangements for the establishment of the Institute, and had been actively associated with it ever since.

The Professor is to be head of the new Unit, responsible for the co-ordination and organization of the teaching of students both in the Hospital and Institute and for the promotion by research and otherwise of the advancement of the subject. The staff of the Unit upon formation, in addition to the Professor, will consist of an Assistant Director and a First Assistant, but the development policy of the Institute provides for the addition of an anatomist, two research assistants, a research radiologist and a research otologist as opportunity affords and the work requires.

DIPLOMA IN LARYNGOLOGY AND OTOTOLOGY

THE Secretary reports to the two Royal Colleges that at the First Part of the Examination for the Diploma in Laryngology and Otology, held on June 10th, 13th, 14th and 15th, 1949, by Mr. C. A. Keogh and Mr. G. H. Bateman, 61 candidates presented themselves, 35 of whom passed; and that at the Second Part of the Examination, held on June 17th, 20th, 21st, 22nd and 23rd, 1949, by Mr. J. H. Cobb and Mr. R. J. Cann, 49 candidates presented themselves, 26 of whom passed.


