## WORDPLAY

**Wordplay** contains four programs which work at the word and sentence level of language, and an authoring program.

- ▶ **Scrambler** - rearrange the jumbled words of a sentence and type them in the correct order
- ▶ **Flasher** - recognise words or sentences, remember them and enter them into the computer
- ▶ **Annagramma** - the letters of a word are mixed up: decipher them and enter the correct word
- ▶ **Alpha Beater** - 26 guesses to find the hidden word which the computer has chosen
- ▶ **Listwriter** - authoring program enabling users to save word or sentence lists of their own

## TEXTPLAY

**Textplay** contains three programs, working at the text level of language, and an authoring program. The programs are:

- ▶ **Context** - a cloze-type program: rebuild a text from nothing except for dashes indicating the number of letters in the words
- ▶ **Hotline** - rearrange the jumbled lines of a text into their correct form
- ▶ **Space Out** - put the punctuation, spaces and capital letters into a text
- ▶ **Textwriter** - authoring program enabling users to save texts of their own

Both **Wordplay** and **Textplay** are available in BBC protected and unprotected versions.

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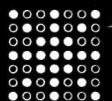
