In the upper half of the image, Ehud gains a private audience with the king of the Moabites, Eglon, and slays him. In the bottom half of the image, Deborah, riding side-saddle, commands Barak and the Israelite forces against the Canaanites. As Alexandra Locking writes in this issue, clerical reformers in the late eleventh and early twelfth centuries drew upon narratives of Deborah’s militancy and authority to encourage the participation of elite laywomen in ecclesiastical reform.
