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In 1967, the American Society for Theatre Research was incorporated under the laws of New Jersey as a nonprofit corporation, and is the only theatre organization in the United States affiliated with the IFTR/FIRT. The ASTR Annual Meeting occurs in the fall of each year.

Theatre Survey, the official journal of ASTR, is published three times a year, in January, May, and September, and is one of the benefits of membership in the Society. ASTR annual dues for North Americans are \$145.00 for individual members, \$65.00 for retired members, \$50.00 for students, and \$95.00 for contingent faculty.
