

### From the Editor

Starting in 2003 *Philosophy of Science* will be mailed out five times a year. The regular issues will be scheduled for January, April, July, and October. (There may be some delays as we switch to the new schedule.) The Proceedings will be shipped separately in December; this move will enable us to qualify for lower postage rates. There will be no change in the total number of journal pages published each year.

In 2002 *Philosophy of Science* went online. Although there were inevitable glitches at the beginning, we are delighted with this additional format. As part of that process authors now receive page proofs as PDF files, which speeds up production. We also plan to make the online version available slightly before the print edition arrives. Soon access will be limited to PSA members (others will still be able to see titles and abstracts).
