

LIBRARIES AND ARCHIVES

The Library of Congress, Washington D.C. has been given a collection of 162 manuscripts relating to the history and culture of Spanish America in the colonial period, 1492–1819, from the collection of Hans P. Kraus, chairman of Kraus-Thomson and author of a new documentary biography of Sir Francis Drake. The collection includes: a contemporary manuscript copy of a 1504 letter from Amerigo Vespucci to Piero Soderini, the 'President' of Florence, discussing all four of his voyages; 49 manuscripts relating to the explorations of Verrazzano; the order book of Luis Velasco the Elder, Viceroy of New Spain; 116 letters and documents from the archive of Fray Juan de Zumárraga and his successors in the see of Mexico, dealing with the first 150 years of Spanish government and administration of that territory; documents illustrating the career of Bartolomé de Las Casas; six dispatches sent in 1819 to Spain from the Viceroy in Mexico containing details about the administration of territories—Texas, Arizona, New Mexico, California—shortly to be subtracted from the Spanish Empire. The Kraus Collection will be available for consultation in the Manuscript Section of the Library of Congress when it has been processed and arranged. The Librarian has said that this gift represents "the most important acquisition of Hispanic materials since the late Edward P. Harkness presented to the Library in 1929 the Harkness Collection of Spanish manuscripts from the early years of the colonial history of Mexico and Peru."

First volume of Latin American Urban Research is planned for early 1970. Co-edited by Francine Rabinovitz and Felicity Trueblood, it will be the first in a series of annual reviews of urban studies in Latin America. The purpose is "to aid researchers and policy planners in systematizing comparisons of the many dimensions and cities and urbanization in Latin America." Each volume will contain an essay on recent urban research on Latin America and a series of 7 or 8 articles on various aspects of urban structure, policy and process, including models and typologies, reports of works on institutional, cultural and environmental conditions, and a bibliographic review. It will be published by Sage Publications, 275, South Berkeley Drive, Beverly Hills, California 90212. With the aid of a grant from the Ford Foundation, the University of Miami

is expanding its holdings of primary research materials on contemporary Cuba. "The Cuban Revolution: A Documentary Guide" by Jaime Suchlicki will be published by the University of Miami Press in June 1970. Purpose of the Guide is to make available resumés and textual excerpts of some of the most significant documents on the Cuban Revolution, including speeches, editorials, manifestos, communiqués, diplomatic notes and official messages. A file of documents has been arranged and indexed. These documents and other collections of material on Cuba are available for study and consultation at the Research Institute for Cuba and the Caribbean, Center for Advanced International Studies, University Studies, University of Miami, Coral Gables, Florida. 33124.

In response to growing demand, a Newspaper Indexing Center and clearinghouse has been established in Flint, Michigan. Its aims are to compile, maintain and publish regularly a complete annotated bibliography of all published and unpublished newspaper indices and index projects. It will make available previously unpublished or out of print newspaper indices. The first such acquisition was an index to the *Toledo Blade* for the years 1920–1940. The center will develop improved techniques for the creation and distribution of newspaper indices and will seek to provide bibliographic control, analysis and synthesis of all published and unpublished literature relating to newspaper index techniques. The 1969 *Index to the National Observer* will be the first of a series of indices of important American newspapers. The center will also provide indexing and consulting services on a contract basis.
