Since 1961, the Survey Research Center, in association with the Institute of International Studies has been developing the **International Data Library and Reference Service**. This is designed to assist social scientists in obtaining, processing and analysing existing materials, with special emphasis on Asia and Latin America. Materials collected include codes, questionnaires and data

in the form of IBM cards. Information is available on political attitudes and behavior, attitudes towards foreign nations and international relations, patterns of stratification and mobilization, family structure relations and family planning, personal and public ethics, religious beliefs and practices, standards of living, material needs and economic outlook as well as other subjects of interest to social scientists. The Reference Service will help scholars collect original material and design their studies, including the drafting of questionnaires and interview guides. The first countries in which information was collected for the Latin American Data Archive were Venezuela and Chile. Borsotti of the Universidad Nacional de Chile and Ruth Hurtado of the Centro de Estudios de Desarrollo de la Universidad Central de Venezuela (CENDES) are regional coordinators. The Instituto Torcuato di Tella, Buenos Aires is to organize the data, and copies of the inventory will be kept in Chile, Venezuela and Buenos Aires. It is number 50 in the series of Cuadernos Bibliotecológicos of the Library Development Program, Department of Cultural Affairs, Pan American Union, Washington, D. C. 20006.

A series of Reports on Brazilian Agriculture has been compiled by William H. Nicholls, Professor of Economics and Director of the Graduate Center for Latin American Studies, Vanderbilt University, and Ruy Miller Paiva, of the Getulio Vargas Foundation, Rio de Janeiro. The series, *Ninety-nine Fazendas: the Structure and Productivity of Brazilian Agriculture 1963* com-

prises regional reports on the Itapecuru Valley of Maranhão, the Cariri Region of Ceará, the Agreste of Pernambuco, the Minas triangle, the North of Paraná, and, (in preparation) the Valley of the Paraíba and Central and Northern Río Grande do Sul. Each report covers in great detail the physical inputs and outputs, gross and net value of sales, cropping patterns and practices, livestock production techniques, land tenure arrangements and net incomes of landlord and worker families, together with various measures of efficiency and productivity of local agriculture. Sections on physical geography and history and a final section on the results of the computation of statistical aggregate production functions are included.
