

THE ROAD TO INDEPENDENCE

Ghana and the Ivory Coast

This work studies the social change that has occurred during the colonial period in two West African States, one under British rule and one under French rule. It traces the changes that colonial administration brings about in the various institutions of the region: the traditional political structures, the economy, the family and religion. It argues that the fundamental colonial situation leads in both territories, despite differences in the form of colonial administration, to similar results, the rise of a nationalist movement which collected the various protests and demands for equality into a single revolutionary movement. The developments in Ghana and the Ivory Coast are traced within a changing world context of change.

The second part of the book describes, with the aid of survey data, the particular role of the emerging network of voluntary associations played in these two countries in these events.

The third section looks at the various elite groups that were involved in the colonial situation and their relation to the rise of nationalism.

This book lies in the borderland between Sociology, Cultural Anthropology and History. The author describes the African administration of the royal capital of Buganda, a hierarchically organized Bantu-speaking tribe in Uganda, East Africa.

Ample attention is given to the system of land tenure in the capital and to its evolution under modern circumstances.

Dr. Gutkind not only carefully analyses the particular situation of the Buganda capital, but points in a final chapter to its more general implications.
