The surveys of the individual branches of the social sciences list the most important books which have appeared in the USSR during the period since the Second World War, including the first half of 1961. Certain works depending on their content, are mentioned in more than one survey. This volume thus provides valuable documentation as to how the methods of dialectical and historical materialism are applied to the various social sciences.
