Call for Abstracts

The East Carolina University School of Medicine, Department of Emergency Medicine, Division of Emergency Medical Services is calling for abstracts for a poster session to be held during the 14th Annual East Coast EMS Seminar. This seminar is cosponsored by the National Association of EMS Physicians and the North Carolina College of Emergency Physicians and is scheduled for 18–20 August 1995.

Abstracts of original research relating to emergency medical services (EMS) should be typed, double-spaced, on one 8.5" x 11" sheet of paper. Only the title and abstract should appear on this sheet. Abstracts should be structured and include: introduction, methods, results, and conclusion. A cover sheet, with the title, authors, and affiliations should be included with each abstract.

Up to 10 abstracts will be selected for poster presentations at the seminar. Awards will be given for the best study and the best poster. Researchers from all disciplines, especially EMS providers, are encouraged to participate.
