It will be issued twice a year and will be concerned with matters of legal interest in Zambia, Africa, and elsewhere. Fortune); and 'A sociological analysis of Ngomahuru isolation hospital' (Sister Mary Aquina). CARDAN: Bulletin d'information et de liaison

THE first number of a new quarterly bulletin, *Recherche, enseignement, documentation africanistes francophones*, covering Black Africa, Madagascar and the Maghreb, has been issued by CARDAN for the collection, classification, and distribution of information on research and teaching in progress and on documentation in the field of francophone African studies. This publication is intended to fill the gap left by the cessation of the *Bulletin d'information* of the Centre de documentation et d'information de la Société des Africanistes, the sixth and last number of which appeared in September 1965. The first number consists of an inventory of Africanist documentary resources in Paris prepared by Joanne Coyle Dauphin, Agnès Rosset, and Britta Rupp. For francophone documentary resources in Belgium and provincial France reference should be made to the articles by Joanne Coyle Dauphin in *African studies Bull.* viii (3), Dec. 1965, pp. 21-39 and 9 (3), Dec. 1966, pp. 48-65. It is not at present intended to publish a list of research workers, since CARDAN is preparing for UNESCO a general index of specialized francophone researches in African studies. A calendar of scientific meetings and Africanist conferences is being independently prepared
