# CRISIS, CONFLICT AND INSTABILITY

## The International Crisis Behavior Project

The International Crisis Behavior (ICB) Project was set up in 1975 as a large-scale investigation into international and foreign policy crises during the twentieth century.

Through the compilation of quantitative data sets, two complementary research paths have been followed: in-depth case studies of states coping with external military-security crises and an aggregate study of the international and foreign policy crises of more than 100 states in the global system from 1929 to 1985. The aim of the research has been to illuminate crisis behavior by identifying patterns of crisis onset, development and outcome.

In 1988, Pergamon Press published the first two volumes from the ICB Project - *Handbook of International Crises* and *Handbook of Foreign Policy Crises*. The third volume, *Crisis, Conflict and Instability*, is to be published in July 1989.

All three volumes are essential reading for academics, students and decision-makers interested in the fields of international relations and political science.

Focusing on specific issues, themes and controversies and ranging across macro- and micro-level topics, the volume explores a range of major issues, including the relationship between polarity, stability and crisis, superpower involvement in international crises, and the effect of structural factors on international crisis behavior.

The volume also includes details of the hitherto unreported crises for the years 1980-85 and provides an agenda for future analysis in the areas of international conflict and crisis.
