



This December issue of *Cardiology in the Young* represents the 10th annual publication in this journal generated from the two meetings that comprise “HeartWeek in Florida.” The nine previous publications were freestanding supplements; however, this year we have transitioned to publishing these proceedings as the regular December issue of *Cardiology in the Young*. HeartWeek 2012 included two meetings:

- All Children’s Hospital hosted its 12th Annual International Symposium on Congenital Heart Disease, sponsored by Johns Hopkins Medicine. The focus was on common arterial trunk and transposition of the great arteries. This meeting was held in Saint Petersburg, Florida, February 17 – 21, 2012.
- The Cardiac Center at The Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia hosted its 16th Annual Update on Pediatric and Congenital Cardiovascular Disease: Developing a Lifelong Interdisciplinary Strategy for Your Patient with Congenital Heart Disease. This meeting was held in Orlando, Florida, February 22 – 26, 2012.

In 2013, the two HeartWeek meetings will not be held in the United States.

The organizers of HeartWeek have decided to cancel the 2013 North American HeartWeek meetings to support the Sixth World Congress of Paediatric Cardiology and Cardiac Surgery that will be held at the Cape Town International Convention Centre in Cape Town, South Africa, February 17 – 22, 2013, under the leadership of Christopher Hugo-Hamman. The Paediatric Cardiac Society of South Africa (PCSSA) is the host and organizer of this prestigious Congress. - On Tuesday, February 19, 2013, The Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia will present the breakfast symposium “Perinatal Care of the Fetus with Congenital Heart Disease.”
- On Thursday, February 21, 2013, All Children’s Hospital and Johns Hopkins Medicine will present the dinner symposium “The Birth of Heart Surgery: Lessons Learned from Tetralogy – Past, Present and Future.”

In 2014, HeartWeek will return to Florida. It will include two conferences:

- The 14th International Symposium on Congenital Heart Disease, organized by All Children’s Hospital and sponsored by Johns Hopkins Medicine, will be held February 14 – 18, 2014, at the **Vinoy® Renaissance Resort & Golf Club** in Saint Petersburg, Florida.
- The 17th Annual Update on Pediatric and Congenital Cardiovascular Disease, organized by The Children’s Hospital of Philadelphia, will be held February 19 – 23, 2014, at **Disney’s Yacht and Beach Club** Resorts in Lake Buena Vista, Florida.


As course directors, we plan the meetings together so they are complementary in focus and have minimal overlap of topics.
