

## MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATION OF THE ROYAL AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND COLLEGE OF PSYCHIATRISTS

The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Psychiatrists is holding its 15th Annual Congress in Singapore in October 1978, and it is intended also to hold the Clinical Section of the College's entry examination on 14, 15 and 16 October 1978. This examination will be open to psychiatrists in South East Asian countries who are in training or who have completed training, and leads to membership of the College.

The preliminary written sections can be taken in

part by correspondence and by special arrangements in the various countries of South East Asia. Inquiries are invited from interested psychiatrists regarding the form and content of the assessment procedure and the nature of any exemptions from sections of the examination, where applicable. ### **Second World Congress of Biological Psychiatry**
