MENTAL HEALTH TRUST AND RESEARCH FUND

At the last two meetings of the Research Committee in November 1972 and January 1973, the following Fellowships and Grants were awarded:

Dr. Gillian M. Cohen, Dept. of Experimental Psychology, University of Oxford: a 3 year Fellowship to study Hemispheric Differences in Selective Attention.

Dr. Charles Pilcher, Dept. of Psychology, University of Birmingham: a 3 year Fellowship to investigate the Biochemical Determinants of Drug Addiction: Biochemical aspects of brain plasticity in relation to the cerebral mechanisms of drug addiction.

Dr. Colin Stolkin, MRC Neuro-immunology Project, Department of Zoology, University College London: a 3 year Fellowship to study Cell surface antigenic markers in the nervous system.

Dr. Elemer Szabadi, Department of Psychiatry, University of Edinburgh: a 3 year Fellowship to study the action of anti-depressant drugs on synaptic transmission in the caudate nucleus.

Dr. R. Morgan, Director of Rehabilitation, St. Wulstan's Hospital, Worcestershire: a 1 year grant for Scientific Assistance to study prognosis, rehabilitation and resettlement of long-stay psychiatric patients.

Dr. Elizabeth Newson, Child Development Research Unit, University of Nottingham: a 2 year grant for expenses to study Parents as Behaviour Modifiers.

Professor D. W. Straughan, The School of Pharmacy, London: a 2 year grant for Scientific Assistance to investigate Brain Monoamines, Amino Acids and Psychoactive Drugs.

Professor D. M. Vowles, University of Edinburgh: a 1 year grant for Scientific Assistance to further investigate patterns of hostility in children.

During the financial year April 1972 to March 1973, the MHRF have awarded a total of 11 new grants, 4 new Fellowships and 7 extensions to existing grants and Fellowships.
