ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

DATES: The conference will begin in the evening of Monday, 25 August, and end in the afternoon of Friday, 29 August 1991.

SUBJECT: Psychophysical, physiological and theoretical studies of visual perception in human and higher vertebrates, including developmental, clinical and applied research of general scientific interest, modeling and computer simulation of visual processing, machine vision and AI.

SYMPOSIUM: A symposium entitled "Neural networks and vision" is planned. The aim of the symposium is to stimulate discussion between researchers working in the field of neural nets and human vision.

PAPERS AND POSTERS: Sessions will be devoted to the presentation of papers (15 minutes + 5 minutes discussion) and posters. They are regarded as being of equivalent scientific standing. Abstracts of both will be published as a supplement to *Perception*.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS: Abstracts and posters should be submitted in 4 copies by 28 February 1991. They should present original, unpublished and substantial research and they should be restricted to a maximum of 180 words, plus authors' names and short form of institutional address.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT: Limited support can be offered to students and young scientists who wish to attend.
