It contains refereed papers describing the results of research that elucidates the nature of phenomena relating to all aspects of weeds and their control. It is published bimonthly, one volume per year, six issues per year beginning in January.

Membership is \$75 per year, student affiliate membership \$30, which includes receipt of *Weed Science*, *Weed Technology*, and *WSSA Newsletter*. Dues should be sent to WSSA, 810 East 10th Street, Lawrence, KS 66044-8897 not later than December 1 of each year. Membership in the society is on a calendar-year basis only.

Subscriptions (institutions, libraries, etc.) to *Weed Science* are \$83 per year, one volume per year of six issues beginning in January. Subscriptions to both *Weed Science* and *Weed Technology* (ISSN 0890-037X) (four issues per volume) are available for \$139 per year.
