

## FORTHCOMING EVENTS

### **South West Thames Regional Health Authority**

A new Regional Psychiatric Day Release Course for the M.R.C.Psych. Final Examination and D.P.M. Part C will commence in September 1974. It will be a collaborative enterprise, taking place on a rotating basis in a number of hospitals. It is intended primarily for junior staff working in hospitals in the Region, but may be open to others if numbers permit. The course is designed to cover the examination syllabus over two years on one day per week for 21 days each year. Further details may be obtained from Dr. E. S. This course complements existing courses available in the Region, including a Day Release Course for the M.R.C.Psych. Preliminary Test and Parts A and B of the D.P.M. at Belmont Hospital, and concentrated courses at Brookwood Hospital and the University of Surrey, to comprise a comprehensive scheme of postgraduate education.

### **Fourth European Conference on Behaviour Therapy**

This year's meeting is arranged by the British Association of Behavioural Psychotherapy and is being held from 11-15 July at the Centre Hotel, London Airport. The scientific programme will

include Symposia on Social Skills Training, Sub-normality, Operant Programmes, Children's Disorders, Marital Problems, Sexual Problems, Phobias, Biofeedback, Behavioural Analysis, Methodology and Assessment, and Training. There will also be guest lectures and sessions of free papers.
