CATHOLIC ACTION AND THE PARISH

by Abbé G. MICHONNEAU and Abbé R. MEURICE

The Abbé Michonneau concentrates on the essential link which should exist between the parish clergy and the local Catholic Actionists so that they might work together under the leadership of the priest for the building up of the Church among all men. He reaffirms the fundamental meaning of the parish as comprising everyone and not merely 'the just'.

The Abbé Meurice concludes the volume with a section on one of the Church's youngest institutes, the Sons of Charity, whose ideal is threefold: the religious life united to parish work plus the apostolate of the poor and the working classes.

In one of his piercing insights into the nature of Christianity St Paul exclaimed: 'For me to live is Christ' (Phil. 1:21). Those words of St Paul are valid for all Christians today. Our principal chore is to allow Christ to form Himself in us, to act through us, to make of us His dwelling place.

The great means given us by our Lord to bring about such a transformation are the sacraments. The redemptive act consummated by Christ on Calvary is communicated to us through these seven channels of grace. By them, we of the twentieth century can be as close to Christ as were our forbears in the Faith.

The sacraments exert an influence on us not only as individuals but also as members of a society, the society founded by Christ and called by St Paul the Mystical Body of Christ. The social aspect of the sacraments at times has not received the attention it deserves. In this work Father Philipon gives adequate consideration to both the individual and the social nature of the sacraments and provides as well many passages suitable for meditation.
