Two Assistant Editors, Dr J Howlett, National Institute for Research in Nuclear Science, Atlas Computer Laboratory, Building R I, Harwell, Didcot, Berks. and Dr. E. T. Goodwin, Superintendent, Mathematics Division, National Physical Laboratory, Teddington, Middlesex are to be particularly concerned with all aspects of applied mathematics, and material for publication should be sent to Dr. Howlett at Harwell. It is hoped shortly to implement the proposal for a journal for mathematicians interested in Technology foreshadowed in the first News-letter.
