A SHORT HISTORY OF MIDWIFERY

By Irving S. Cutter, M.D. (1875–1945) and Henry R. Viets, M.D.

The historical introduction by Dr. Cutter to Curtis' 3-volume classic *Obstetrics and Gynecology* which was first published in 1933 still stands today—as it did 30 years ago—as one of the best accounts of the development of midwifery from 14th-century England to 19th-century America.
