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# Invasive Plant Science and Management

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Cover Photo: Shown is the invasive weedy plant *Lonicera japonica* Thunb., commonly known as Japanese honeysuckle. This plant, a member of the Caprifoliaceae family, is native to east Asia and introduced into many countries around the world, including the U.S. It is a perennial vine that produces fragrant flowers and overtops other plants, reducing light available for native species.
