

Since the inception of our grant program, we have assisted over 120 researchers and provided over \$620,000 in funding to EM research projects. Typically, our grants act as catalysts for future research and play a vital role in advancing EM research.

Due to the success of our membership fundraising campaign, we expanded our grant competition by offering three \$10,000 EMAF grants, as well partnerships with CanVECTOR and SREMI to provide matched funds for additional junior investigator grants over the next few years.

This is not enough. The demand for research funding currently exceeds our capacity, but with your support we are aiming to double our EM grant program.
