INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ORIENTALISTS

The XXVII International Congress of Orientalists will be held at The University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan, U.S.A., 13th to 19th August, 1967, under the auspices of the Association for Asian Studies and the American Oriental Society. The President of the Congress is Professor W. Norman Brown, University of Pennsylvania. The Secretary General is Professor Russell H. Fifield, University of Michigan. The Organizing Committee for the XXVII Congress is made up of W. Norman Brown, Chairman; John K. Fairbank, Harvard University; Albrecht Goetze, Yale University; L. Carrington Goodrich, Columbia University; John W. Hall, Yale University; G. E. von Grunebaum, University of California, Los Angeles; and John A. Wilson, University of Chicago.

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON ASIAN HISTORY

The next of these conferences sponsored by the International Association of Historians of Asia will take place at the University of Malaya in August, 1968. The field to be covered embraces South-east, South, and East Asia, and the conference will be divided into sections dealing with prehistory, proto-history, indigenous historiography, the impact of the West, and 20th-century history.
