It is preferred that manuscripts be typed double-spaced, including quotes and footnotes. In general, the Canadian Journal of Philosophy follows the University of Chicago Manual of Style. Footnotes should be numbered consecutively and assembled on separate pages at the end of the manuscript. Clear and legible photocopies are acceptable. Manuscripts will not be returned unless return postage is prepaid by cheque, money-order, reply coupons, or Canadian stamps.
