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The Society for the Promotion of Hellenic Studies, generally known as the Hellenic Society, was founded in 1879 to advance the study of Greek language, literature, history, art and archaeology in the Ancient, Byzantine and Modern periods. It has done this ever since by various means, chief among them being the annual publication of the *Journal of Hellenic Studies* and, since the 1950's, its supplement, *Archaeological Reports*, which are both supplied free of charge to members of the Society. Occasional monographs also appear in the series *Supplementary Papers*.

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
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
