Membership in the Association is open to any one interested in its work. Annual dues for students are \$8.00. Dues for other individual members are \$15.00 per year. Dues include subscription to the current volume of the Journal. For their personal use, all members may purchase back issues at 25% discount.

For nonmembers, subscription to the current volume of the Journal is \$40 per year. Back volumes may be purchased at \$20 per volume for volumes 1–17, \$25 per volume for volumes 18–36, \$45 for volume 37, \$53 for volume 38, and \$60 for volume 39.

If an article is of more than thirty-two (printed) pages in length, the editors reserve the right to divide it between two or more, not necessarily consecutive, numbers. Authors receive fifty reprints of each article, with covers, and additional reprints may be purchased if desired.

The Association assesses page charges at the rate of \$30.00 per page for all papers (excluding reviews) that appear in the JOURNAL. All bills for page charges will be submitted to the author's host institution or employing company, if any. Authors are not liable for the payment of page charges, nor for their acceptance and payment by employing organizations.
