

## **Dissertation Abstracts**

Recent Ph.D.s (e.g., within 6 months of defending the thesis) are invited to submit abstracts, no longer than 400 words, for publication in this section of *Experimental Economics*.

Submissions should be accompanied by a short letter of support from the advisor/supervisor, which will not be published. These abstracts are not peer-reviewed, but they are assessed by the Co-Editors to determine whether their content and quality are suitable for the journal. Of course, an important criterion is that the dissertation should use laboratory or field experiments.
