## LIBRARIES AND ARCHIVES

### **Akademische Druck Has Catalogues on Series**

A special catalogue, *Americana*, issued by the Akademische Druck, contains bibliographical data on important works of ancient America published by the institution. Listed publications include facsimile editions of ancient Mexican manuscripts; included in the series Codices Selecti are the Codices Becker I/II, Codex Vindobonensis Mexicanus I, Codex Egerton 2895 (Codex Waecker Götter), Codex Tro-Cortesianus (Codex Madrid), Codex Peresianus (Codex Paris), Codex Laud, Codex Cospi, Codex Magliabecchiano CL.XIII.3 (BR 232), and Codex Vaticanus B (Codex Vaticanus 3773). Another series, Bibliotheca Linguistica Americana, includes such publications as *Vocabulario de Mayathan*, by Diego Rejón Arias, and *Arte de la lengua maya* by Gabriel de San Bonaventura. ### **Brandeis University Acquires Bolivian Collection**

The Brandeis University Library recently acquired a collection on politics and union activity in Bolivia from Guillermo Lora, secretary general of the Partido Obrero Revolucionario of Bolivia. The collection contains approximately 500 books and pamphlets dealing with material on the twentieth century, with extensive coverage of political parties, the labor movement in Bolivia, the 1952 revolution, and political crises of the Barrientos regime. ### Center for Inter-American Relations Pursues Maya Glyphs Project

A \$50,000 grant from the Stella and Charles Guttman Foundation has initiated a project sponsored by the Center for Inter-American Relations, Inc., to prepare a universal looseleaf *corpus* of accurate reproductions of all known Maya hieroglyphs. The project is the first step in a long-term effort to translate the ancient Maya writing. Appointed director of planning for the program is Ian Graham, Peabody Museum, Harvard University. An advisory committee has also been appointed; members are Edgar Brenner, Guttman Foundation, chairman, Ignacio Bernal, Instituto Nacional de Antropología e Historia, México, Stanton Catlin, Center for Inter-American Relations, Michael Coe, Yale University, Gordon Ekholm, American Museum of Natural History, Floyd Lounsbury, Yale University, Luis Jujan Muñoz, Instituto Nacional de Antropología e Historia, Guatemala, and Tatiana Proskouriakoff, Harvard University. ### Caribbean Regional Bibliographical Center Reports

### **Guatemalan National Atlas to be Published**

The Instituto Geográfico Nacional de Guatemala announces the forthcoming publication of the Guatemalan National Atlas. ### **Oxford University Library Catalogs Mexican Pamphlets**

The Bodleian Library of Oxford University has recently catalogued in depth a collection of Mexican pamphlets, most of which were printed between 1820 and 1827. The pamphlets, previously only catalogued under a general heading, are bound in some 40 volumes. Major authors represented in the collection, which was obtained by the library in 1875, include José Fernández de Lizardi and Pablo de Villavicencio. ### **PAIGH Committee on Applied Geography Has Microfilm Project**

The Committee on Applied Geography of the Pan American Institute of Geography and History has undertaken a project to disseminate in microfilm form current statistical data for Latin American countries. Library of Congress holdings of socio-economic statistics are to be reproduced. University libraries which choose to participate in the project by purchasing the film will share the cost of reproduction and positive printing. Total cost to the libraries will depend on the number of participating institutions; it is expected that, with 20 universities subscribing, each library can obtain all holdings reproduced for less
