Footnotes should be numbered consecutively and assembled on separate pages at the end of the manuscript. Clear and legible photocopies are acceptable. Manuscripts will not be returned unless return postage is prepaid by cheque, money-order, reply coupons, or Canadian stamps.

It is with deep sadness that the Editors of the Journal report the death of Steven C. Patten. Steve joined the Executive Editorial Board of the *CJP* in 1978, and directed the editorial administration of the Journal at the University of Lethbridge from 1980 onwards.

Steve brought enormous dedication, warmth and energy to his work as an editor. He had a strong commitment to the Journal, seeing it as distinctive among philosophical journals in combining a broad and balanced coverage of the entire discipline with topicality, yet without sacrificing standards of excellence in scholarship. Steve made an important contribution to the editorial process; his thoughtful advice and tempered judgment were highly valued by the other editors and often decisively influenced editorial policy. During his period as an editor, he co-edited three *CJP* Supplementary Volumes, *New Essays on John Stuart Mill and Utilitarianism* (1979), *Marx and Morality* (1981) and *New Essays in Ethics and Public Policy* (1982).

In addition to his journal activities, Steve was very well regarded as a teacher of philosophy at the University of Lethbridge, and was the author of numerous publications in the field.

A memorial fund has been established in Steve's memory by his family. The fund will provide scholarship aid to a worthy student at the University of Lethbridge. Friends of Steve who would like to contribute should send their contributions to:
