This Index distinguishes between different categories of names according to the following conventions: Names of deities, heroes and fictional characters are capitalized; modern and contemporary individuals are in small capitals; names of ancient Greek individuals are in normal characters; among the ancient authors, only those who were in some way involved in the events of 404/3 are indexed; we have specified the demotic of Athenian citizens (if known), and for noncitizens their status.
