**HEGEL ESSAY PRIZE**

The Hegel Society of Great Britain is pleased to announce that it will be running an essay prize competition in 1998, for which entries are now invited. The closing date for entries is 31 May 1998, and the prize will be awarded by 16 August 1998, after which the winner will be informed.

The competition is open to those who are registered postgraduate students (MA, MPhil, or PhD) at the time of the closing date, and who are studying at universities in the UK or Ireland, or who are studying in other countries but are members of the HSGB.

Entries can be on any topic relevant to Hegel's work, and should be not more than 6000 words in length, including footnotes and bibliography. Two copies of each entry should be sent, prepared for blind refereeing, with a cover sheet giving name, address, current status (MA etc) and word count.

The prize will consist in an award of £100, and the winning essay will be considered for publication in the *Bulletin of the Hegel Society of Great Britain*. The judges reserve the right to divide the award between winners if necessary.
