OTHER PUBLICATIONS OF THE SOCIETY

The *JOURNAL SERIES B*. This series contains papers on applied mathematics. It is published in volumes comprising four parts, starting with Volume XIX Part 1, 1975. Four parts will be published in 1997; the price to non-members is A\$210 (US\$172) for 1997. Typescripts for publications should be sent to the Editor, Associate Professor C. E. M. PEARCE, Department of Applied Mathematics, University of Adelaide, SA 5005, Australia.

The *BULLETIN* of the Australian Mathematical Society began publication in 1969. It aims at quick publication of original research in all branches of mathematics. Two volumes of three numbers are published annually. The price to non-members is A\$285 (US\$230) for 1997. Each paper for publication should include an abstract and a 1991 Mathematics Subject Classification. Three copies of the typescript should be sent to the Editorial Office, Bulletin, Australian Mathematical Society, Department of Mathematics, The University of Queensland, QLD 4072, Australia.

The *GAZETTE* started publication in 1974 and carries news items, mathematical articles of general interest, and articles on tertiary mathematics teaching. The price to non-members is A\$55 (US\$44) for 1997. Typescripts for publication should be sent to the Editor, Prof. T. M. MILLS, Department of Mathematics, La Trobe University, P. O.
