



It publishes papers from both professionals and amateurs on all aspects of ornithology ranging from geographical distribution to bird behaviour, covering topics such as kin selection, altruism and breeding systems. Reviews of the ornithological literature have always been an important feature of the journal. Although it

is published for the British Ornithologists' Union it is by no means exclusively British, and less than half the papers deal with British birds.
