As part of this effort, we would like to call your attention to a Special Issue of *JPP* edited by us and entitled: *Present achievements and new frontiers in space plasmas*.

The issue is open to any contribution based on the most recent achievements and progress in *Space Plasma Physics*. We invite you to submit a paper within one of the following main themes:

- Basic models and fundamental processes in space plasmas
- Simulation of space plasmas: from fluid to kinetic models
- Fundamental plasma processes in space weather
- Recent achievements of space missions and future projects

Papers may be regular research papers or in the style of a review. We also particularly encourage papers proposing new concepts for future space missions, as they will be fundamental in making further progress in this field.

We propose a submission deadline of **June 1, 2014** and plan to have the articles published before the end of the year.
