King Henry V's British captains -- Fluellen (Welsh), Gower (English), MacMorris (Irish), and Jamy (Scots) -- are often costumed to represent their home countries. In this photograph from a production at the London Lyceum theatre in 1900, E. M. Robson's leek, tucked into the strap of his helmet, would have helped audiences instantly identify him as Fluellen.
