A painting by R W. Satchwell is thought to be the source of this engraving of the final scene of *Love's Labour's Lost* by William Ridley. Ridley was a prolific portrait engraver in the late eighteenth century, producing engravings of famous faces like Mary Wollstonecraft, John Dryden, and Henry V.
