Much of the comedy in *The Comedy of Errors* comes from the confusion between the two sets of twins. Kenny Meadows capitalized on this in a drawing for one of the many mid-nineteenth century illustrated Shakespeares, depicting Antipholus of Syracuse's encounter with a courtesan in Act 4, Scene 3.
