This watercolor and pencil drawing of Act 3, Scene 4 of *Twelfth Night* or *What You Will* was probably painted by George Cruikshank. In this scene, Malvolio (at the far left of the drawing) appears in outlandish and ridiculous garb, having been fooled by a forged letter into thinking such clothing will impress the Countess Olivia.
