Shakespeare's *Venus and Adonis* is an epyllion, part of an extremely popular genre of poems based on love stories from Roman mythology. Most epyllia source their stories from Ovid's *Metamorphoses*, which was a common text used to teach Latin in early modern English grammar schools. This scene from *Venus and Adonis* depicts the titular character's meeting in a cave where they consummate their relationship.
